Presentation Day Instructions

- A member of the Education Department will arrive approximately 15-20 minutes before the start of the presentation, unless more set up time is necessary. Please be sure to have everything ready for the presenter upon arrival including a table for the animals to be placed on, chairs for longer events, and a working microphone (for large presentations).
- Chehaw is one of two zoos in the state of Georgia that is accredited by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (www.aza.org/about-aza/). This accreditation is achieved by upholding a high standard of care for our animal collection. In order to ensure the highest quality care possible we require your assistance when planning to bring live animals to your event or facility.
 1. Please be conscious of the weather when planning your event and presentation location, if temperatures are too hot or too cold an indoor facility will be required.
 2. As an AZA accredited facility we are required to keep our animals separate from animals outside the zoo collection. If there are other animals that will be at your event, please be sure to alert the Education Coordinator so that the appropriate accommodations can be made.
